ATTACHING YOUR UNIVERSAL WINDSHIELD PDA MOUNT

1. Attach the PDA cradle to the flex arm by aligning the slot on the back of the cradle with the swivel plate attached to the arm bracket.



WARNING: DO NOT rely only on the suction-cup as the primary means of supporting the mounting arm and your PDA. The weight of the PDA, heat on the windshield, and the condition of road being traveled (bumps) could possibly cause the arm to detach and cause damage to the PDA if the arm was not properly shaped and supported by the dashboard.

2. Peel the protective paper off the suction cup, and decide how you want to shape the mount so it attaches to the windshield and a portion rests on the dashboard for support.
3. Use a glass cleaner to clean the inside of the windshield where the suction cup will be mounted. *(This is very important to obtain a good suction, especially if you smoke in the vehicle)*
4. Pull the toggle lever on the mount away from the suction cup, place the cup against the glass, and move the toggle lever towards the cup securing it in place
5. Re-shape the arm if required so that a portion of it is resting on the dashboard as pictured above.
6. Place the PDA in the cradle and squeeze the side clamps securely against it to hold your PDA in place.
7. To release your PDA, simply press the release button located on the left-side bottom of the cradle.
