Thank you for purchase of GPSTrackP system, a low-cost yet powerful GPS tracking system for vehicle and driver management.

The RBT3000 is actually two products in one!

I. It can be used as a stand-alone device plugged into a standard 12VDC cigarette lighter, (no laptop PC required) to record travel data such as route, speed and mileage summaries, complete with date and time stamps.

II. It can also function as an optional Bluetooth GPS receiver for your laptop PC for real-time in car navigation. By connecting the RBT3000 with your laptop wirelessly via Bluetooth and installing any NMEA compliant street mapping or navigation software, you can view your location in relation to surrounding streets allowing you to make efficient travel routes.

1. GETTING STARTED

There are only a few simple steps you need to follow before using your GPSTrackP system:

- First install the GPSTrackP software on your PC.
- Set-up the RBT3000 and GPS antenna in your vehicle.
- **OPTIONAL:** If you'll be using the RBT3000 as a GPS receiver for real-time navigation, you will also need a laptop PC with a street mapping or navigation software.

NOTE: Before using your RBT3000 (especially the first-time), the GPS must first obtain a local GPS fix (coordinates) of your current position. This can take up to several minutes.

2. INSTALL GPSTRACKP SOFTWARE

It is required that you install GPSTrackP software before you can download and view the data from your RBT3000 unit. To install GPSTrackP, insert the GPSTrackP installation CD-ROM into your PC. Your PC's autorun feature should start the installation automatically, however if your PC's autorun feature is disabled, select the GPSTrackP.msi file on the CD-ROM to manually start the installation process.

IMPORTANT:

GPSTrackP software is based on Microsoft Mappoint. It is required that you have a legal copy of Mappoint 2002 or later version installed on your PC to run GPSTrackP.

3. INSTALL RBT3000 UTILITY PROGRAM

To download data from RBT3000, you need to install the RBT3000 utility program. To install the utility program, insert the BlueGPS installation CD-ROM into your PC. Your PC's autorun feature should present a program installation menu to you. Select the software that matches your operating system and install it following the instructions.

4. SET-UP RBT3000 FOR RECORDING

Follow the user manual of RBT3000 to enable its data logger function and set the recording time interval and data formats to your preference.

Fix the RBT3000 box in a safe place. You can place it on the dashboard without using an external antenna. You can also purchase an external antenna, and then you can fix RBT3000 inside the vehicle.

Connect power cable to the RBT3000 unit and plug the opposite end of the power cable into the cigarette lighter.

Check the LED DISPLAY to make sure RBT3000 works properly. Details refer to the user manual of RBT3000.

After you turn on the RBT3000 unit, it will start to record data. Turning off the power will stop recording data. This is recommended when the vehicle will be parked for extended periods of time such as airport parking or when being serviced.

5. INITIALIZE THE GPS

During initialization the GPS LED will be green in solid indicating that the unit is powered on but NOT receiving a GPS signal and is not recording data. Once the RBT3000 has completed the GPS initialization, the GPS LED will change to twinkle indicating a GPS fix has been obtained and recording has started.

6. VIEW YOUR TRIPS

To view your recorded trips follow these steps:

1. Follow the user manual of RBT3000 to download the data from RBT3000.
2. Process the data by converting to NMEA format and save the processed data to the directory: "<GPSTrackP installation directory>/data/GPSdata/*.log".
3. Click on GPSTrackP's desktop icon to run GPSTrackP software.
4. After you logon, click "Data Loader" button and then you will see the log file on the file list.
5. Select the log file and specify the device ID, then click the button "Process" to update the database.

Note: You may add the RBT3000 as a tracking device into the Device Manager and assign a vehicle and driver to it before you process the data. How to do this, you can refer to online help of GPSTrackP software for details.

6. With the processed data, you can view trip day by day and track the driver's activities during different time periods.

WARNING: Keep your eyes on the road.

It is your responsibility as the vehicle operator to keep your eyes on the road and be an alert driver at all times, ESPECIALLY when the vehicle is moving. The vehicle operator should not be distracted by the navigation equipment or software. Should there be a distraction with the ability to drive responsibly, please turn off the device. Should you want to look at the display for a prolonged time, park the car safely, while following all traffic regulations before looking at the display.
